

## GCSE MOVING IMAGE ARTS

### EXAMINING BOARD: CCEA

#### ***Course Content:***

This qualification has been designed to provide students develop audio-visual literacy skills and creativity using digital technology. They will also be encouraged in areas such as self-expression, exploration of thoughts and ownership of their own ideas.

#### ***You will study...***

- ***Unit 1:*** Acquisition of Skills in Moving Image Production: You will learn the key skills in two of the following film areas – camera technique, sound, lighting, mise-en-scene, editing, animation, post-production
- ***Unit 2:*** Planning and Making a Moving Image Product: You will be given the chance to produce your own moving image creative piece.
- ***Unit 3:*** Critical Response to Moving Image Product: You will study a series of set films and analyse them using film language terms such as genre and visual style.

#### ***You will be assessed in the following way...***

The assessment process is designed to enable learners to obtain recognition and reward for what they achieve and produce. The first two units are entirely coursework based and are internally assessed and externally moderated.

*The two set tasks from Unit 1 are worth a combined 20%.*

In Unit 2 students are assessed under the criteria of thinking, planning, making and evaluating their moving image product.

*Unit 2 is worth 40% of the overall grade.*

Unit 3 is an online examination where student are shown brief sequences from the set film texts before answering questions on them.

*Unit 3 is worth 40% of the overall grade.*

#### ***Future Prospects***

If you see yourself as a creative person with an interest in any or all aspects of video production then this course will benefit you greatly. Film and television production have increased substantially in recent years especially in Northern Ireland, with a corresponding need in a technically skilled workforce. Also the skills learnt in this course are very transferable to other sectors of the digital technology industry and beyond.

The course is also designed as a gateway to the GCE in Moving Image Arts, as well as many degree courses such as Film Studies at Queen's University Belfast.
