

Eligibility Criteria

Hazelwood College is an all-ability, co-educational, integrated school.

The Board of Governors seeks to maintain a reasonable balance between Catholic and Protestant students as outlined in the statement of principles of the Northern Ireland Council for Integrated Education.

The Board of Governors delegates to an Admissions Committee, consisting of the Principal and three governors, the responsibility for applying the criteria in the selection of Year 8 students. Such selections will be based on the College admissions criteria and will be approved by the Board of Governors.

The College admissions criteria set out below will be applied separately in the order they appear to applicants from Protestant and Roman Catholic backgrounds. 20% of places will be reserved for 'Others' who may be from a 'mixed-tradition' background, from a different religious/ethnic grouping or from those of no religious affiliation.

All relevant information **must** also be included on the Transfer Form to enable the Committee to apply the criteria fairly. This should include the category the child belongs to, family connections with school, child's place in the family and type of school: integrated, single-sex, co-educational.

Prospective parents should indicate below which category they want their son/daughter to be included in and which of the criteria overleaf he/she meets.

In the event of the surnames beginning with the same initial letter the subsequent letters of the surnames will be used in alphabetical order; names beginning with Mc or Mac will be ranked as in the telephone directory. In the event of two identical surnames the alphabetical order of the initials of the forenames will be used.
