

Year 9 Music Project



Task: Complete a Project on your favourite artist/performer/singer or DJ

Each student in Year 9 is required to complete a piece of project work on their favourite Group, DJ, singer or performer.

Each student must:

1. Choose a Pop group, singer or performer that you would like to know more about.
2. Research the selected performer by gathering information from a variety of Primary and Secondary sources to include:
 - a. The Internet
 - b. CD's/Vinyl covers
 - c. Magazines /Books
 - d. DVD's /Video's
 - e. Any other source you can think of
3. Once you have the relevant information select the research material that you think would be relevant for your project. Make sure you include some information on the following areas within your project:
 - a) Some background information on your chosen group, singer or performer.i.e. The life and times of
 - b) Information about their hit songs.
 - c) Images /Pictures

- d) Information on the style and sort of music they play/sing
 - e) Reasons why you like the group or person
 - f) Analyse and talk about your favourite song and why you like it
4. You must also create a Promotional poster advertising your favourite performer/artist. Select relevant images from your sources and present your work on the attached A3 page.
5. Your project must include the following pages and be presented in the following way:
- a) Front Cover showing your name and your selected performer/artist.
 - b) Content page – list all your pages and what information is included in each.
 - c) All your research – Life and Times/Images/Hit songs/Favourite song etc- each of your research pages should be at least one page long.
 - d) Bibliography – a list of websites and books etc you used to complete your project.
6. **Assessment:** This project is worth 40% of your end of year Assessment. The other 60 % is your summer exam. You will be assessed on the following: Presentation of your work, Selection of relevant information, Spelling and grammar and overall effort and application.

Extension work: If you have access to a computer, you may present your work in the form of a power point or a word processed project. If not, please write on pages using the required layout above.
