



## THE HAZELWOOD LESSON

- 1 Line up quietly outside the class.
  Staff will meet and greet students into the classroom/work area.
- 2. Prepare to learn: coats/blazers off, books and equipment out.
  - √ Homework Planner
  - ✓ Use your equipment checklist, Book Presentation checklist and Green Pen Guide
  - ✓ Respond to your name when the teacher is completing the register
- 3 Wait quietly for staff to begin teaching and learning activities.
- 4 Your lesson will have three sections to it:
  - a) Introduction: WHAT are we going to learn today?
     Learning Objectives / Intentions / Success Criteria;
  - b) Variety of learning tasks: i.e. pair-work, individual-work, group-work, whole class;
  - c) **Conclusion:** What have we learnt? (Review / Recap / Revise / Summarise).

Use the traffic lights in your planner if you require help with your learning.

- 5 Record your **HOMEWORK** in your Planner.
- 6 Tidy-up time.
- 7 Staff will end the lesson and prepare to send you to your next lesson.
- 8 End and Send Time.

## **Important points:**

- Raise your hand when you need attention, or use the Traffic Light pages in your planner.
- Staff want to praise and promote good behaviour, e.g.:
  - Subject Stamps / Certificates;
  - Special Achievement Postcards:
  - Special mention in the class Record Book.
