



The Electoral Office for Northern Ireland is responsible for the electoral registration of all constituencies in Northern Ireland. They are responsible for all elections and referendums in Northern Ireland. They advise the Secretary of State for Northern Ireland by 16 April each year whether or not a registration canvass should be conducted. They act as an assessor to the Boundary Commission for Northern Ireland. At times of election they employ over 5000 to work in Polling stations across Northern Ireland and at the various count venues. The EONI manages a vast data base and employs data analysts to continuously improve how we handle that data and increase accessibility to the public and the efficiency of services. From 18 June 2018 the EONI will provide digital registration online for the first time in Northern Ireland.
